Fee Collection :-

- 1. The guardians are requested to pay the fee on time
- Fee card must be brought at the time of fee payment.

- 4. Only Green card holders will be allowed to appear in the test/exam. This card will be issued to a student only when his/her all dues are clear.
- 5. The Principal reserves to himself/herself the right to dismiss a student, whose attendance is irregular, who fails to make satisfactory progress in his/her studies or whose conduct in anyway is detrimental to the discipline of the institution, for immorality, Insubordination or contempt or whose sickness is liable to be injurious to other students may be dismissed without prior notice to the parents.

- 7. No school leaving certificate will be issued unless requested in writing by parent and the dues are

Conveyance

- 1. The students who want to avail the school vehicle facility will have to fill and submit the conveyance form with the guardian's sign at the time of admission.
- 2. The guardian will have to abides by all the rules and regulations printed in the conveyance form.
- 3. Even for the partial use of the conveyance, fees of 11 months will be charged.
- 4. Conveyance facilities may be withdrawn for disciplinary reasons.
- 5. Conveyance facilities will be stopped if the conveyance fee of 1 month falls due. From the 2nd month no conveyance facility will be provided.
